

JACKET COMBAT PC DISRUPTIVE WITH INDIAN ARMY LOGO

PURPOSE (END USE):

Jacket Combat Polyester Cotton (20:80) Disruptive with Indian Army Logo has been developed to improve fabric with new camouflage design and Indian Army Logo for Army. This Jacket is manufactured for the use during combat duties in combination with Trousers made of same fabric.

Fabric

The khaki dyed base fabric is printed with three colour disruptive pattern of brown, green and black colour using Vat-Disperse dyes. "Indian Army along with cross swords" Logo also printed in English and Hindi at specified intervals. This design has been registered under class 05-05 (Textile fabrics) of Designs Act 2001 in the name of OCF Avadi.

Garment features:

1. Two large Chest-Pockets in Cargo-Design with pouching.
2. Rectangular Pocket-Flaps
3. Hidden button and button hole arrangement on front placket and pockets.
4. Adjustable strap at back waist & sleeve open.
5. Pen-Pocket at left side seam.
6. Large reversible buttons (19 mm)
7. One piece Safari type collar with fusible interlining.
8. Reinforcement piece at sleeve elbow from inside of sleeve.
